## Previous Maths Quiz

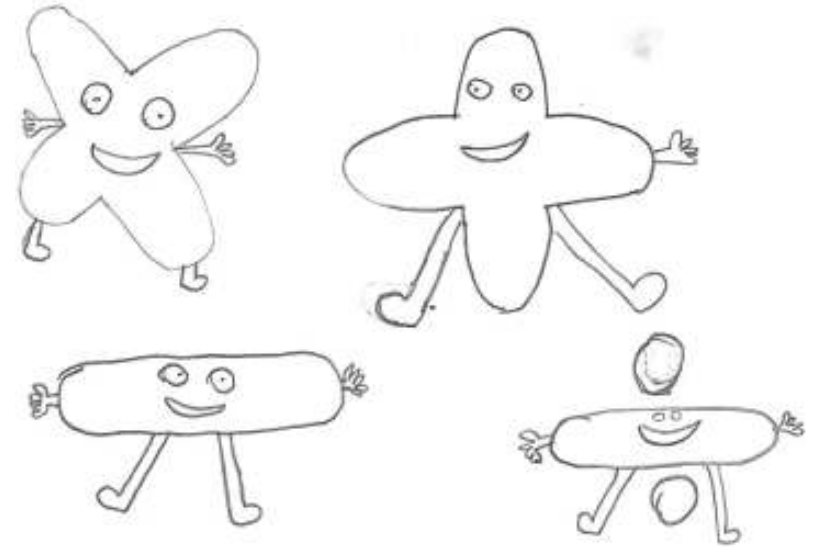
Well done to all the children who took part in the maths challenge. The child who won the maths prize this term was Isla Fenn in Fireflies.
